

Senior Archaeologist - Honolulu, Hawai'i

Requirements include a M.A. or Ph.D. degree in anthropology, archaeology, historical archaeology, or related field; a minimum of 5 years of supervisory or management experience in CRM, and previous experience in Hawai'i or the Pacfici Islands; and the candidate must be permittable with the State of Hawai'i as a qualified archaeologist. Prior Project Manager experience, including budgets and personnel is preferred. Additionally, the ideal candidate should have experience with business development and staff mentorship, strong technical writing skills, excellent organizational and communication skills, and an ability to positively interact with clients.
