Requirements include a M.A. or Ph.D. degree in anthropology, archaeology, historical archaeology, or related field; a minimum of 5 years of supervisory or management experience in CRM, and previous experience in Nevada; and the candidate must be able to be permitted by the Nevada Bureau of Land Management at the Crew Chief level or higher for both prehistoric and historic resources throughout most of northern and central Nevada and portions of northeastern California. Prior Project Manager experience, including budgets and personnel is preferred. Register of Professional Archaeologists (RPA) certification also required. Additionally, the ideal candidate should have experience with business development and staff mentorship, strong technical writing skills, excellent organizational and communication skills, and an ability to positively interact with clients.
